Give gifts of time and financial resources in support of the church's work.

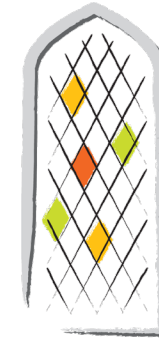
An Invitation to Prayer
